





Modern Hawaiian Baby Quilt

A Free quilt pattern. from Craft Sisters™

Modern Hawaiian Baby Quilt

Finished size approx. 44" x 50"

Materials

2.5" x 44" strips of scrap fabrics (sew scrap strips end-to-end to get length if needed).

64 2.5" x 2.5" squares for flying geese blocks

32 2.5" x 4.5" rectangles for flying geese blocks

2 3" squares, contrasting colors

2-1/4 yd. backing fabric

3/8 yd binding

Batting

Flying Geese Blocks - Make 32




Place the edges of a 2.5" backround square on top of a 2.5" x 4.5" rectangle right sides together. Mark and then sew on the diagonal line (dotted line on diagram). Trim 1/4" away (on solid line) from the seam line and press seam out.

Squares are the background, geese are rectangles. Fabrics should contrast.


Repeat the process on the other side. Be sure to press first seam out before sewing the other side. Block is complete. There should be a 1/4" seam allowance on either side and top of block.




Half-square Triangles - Make 2



Lay light 3" square on top of darker 3" square. Draw line.



Sew 1/4" seam on either side of line.
Cut on drawn line.



Press seam toward dark. Trim to 2.5" square. Yield 2 Sew quilt together as shown below. 23 vertical strips sewn lengthwise for lower section. Three rows of flying geese blocks and one horizontal strip, upper section. Trim lower section as needed to same width as top and sew two sections together.

Easy quilting suggestion - Quilt vertical lines in varying widths. Or any overall pattern would work well too. Have fun and make it bright!
